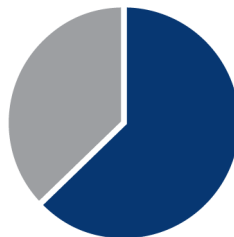

PSAT SCORES AND ADVANCED COURSES

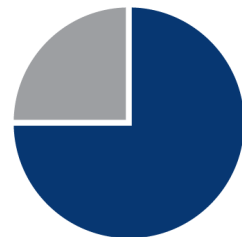
Percent of students whose PSAT test scores indicate they are college and career ready. Percent of student population who are enrolled in at least one advanced course.

CLUBS

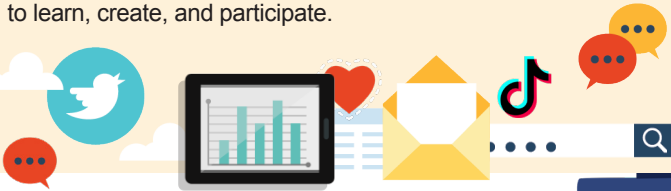
