- Through our Dual-Language program, students can develop bilingualism and biliteracy.

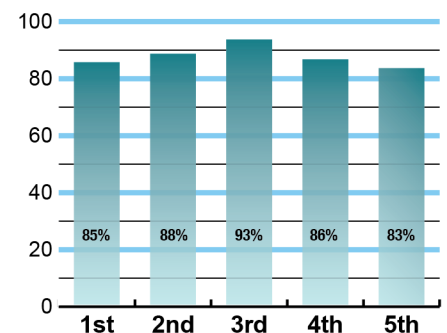
