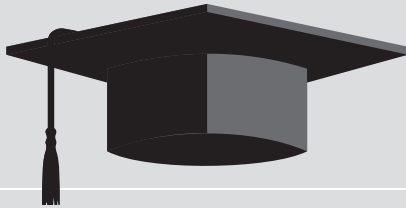

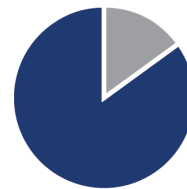

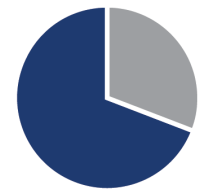
SAT Reading/Writing

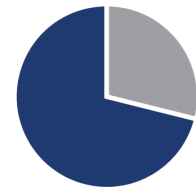

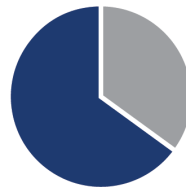

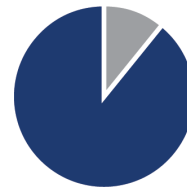

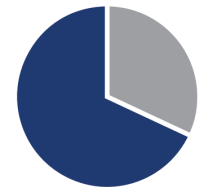
