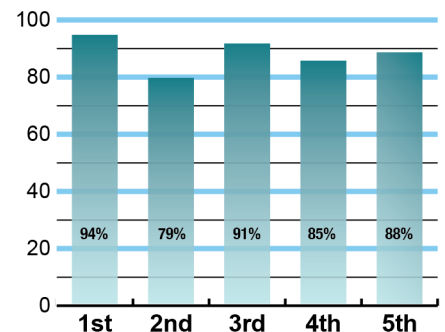

In April 2024, we asked 4th and 5th grade students about adults they could confide in at our school. Values represent the percentage of students who agreed with the following.

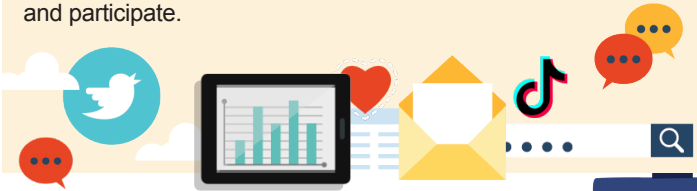
