- Building a climate of mutual respect to improve risk-taking and trust

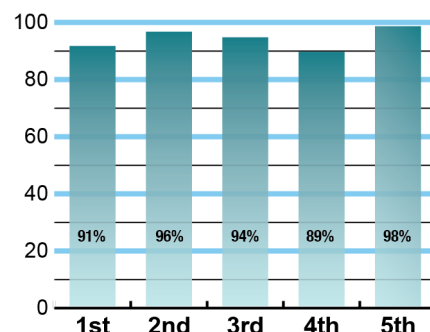
