- Students are active participants in their own education today leading to their future


At Forestwood, our vision is a learning community that challenges all members to reach their individual potential and prepares them to realize their unique role in a caring community.




ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

PSAT SCORES AND ADVANCED COURSES


Percent of students whose PSAT test scores indicate they are college and career ready. Percent of student population who are enrolled in at least one advanced course.
