All students have the opportunity to engage in inclusive experiences that ensure each child has the academic skills and social emotional support needed to be successful.

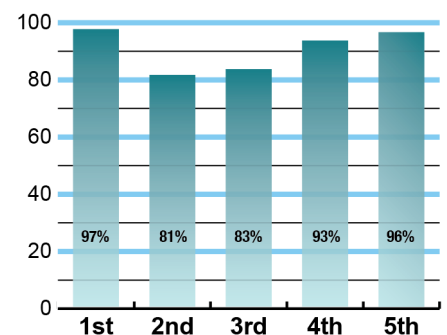
Through hands-on activities, community partnerships, field trips, and real-world experiences students are challenged to push beyond themselves in order to have more meaningful and relevant learning experiences.
