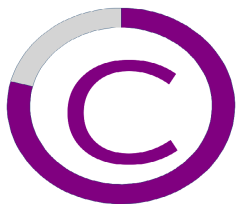

**Accountability Ratings**

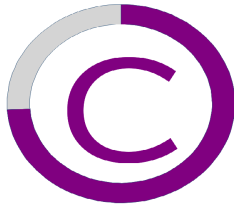

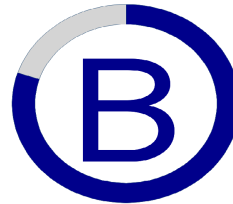

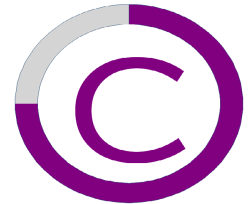
