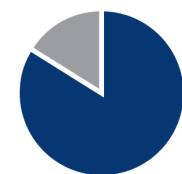

Percent of graduates from the class of 2024

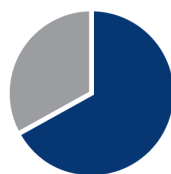

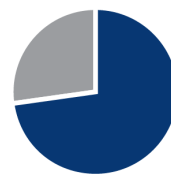

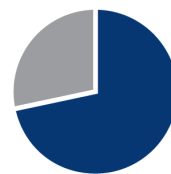

CLUBS

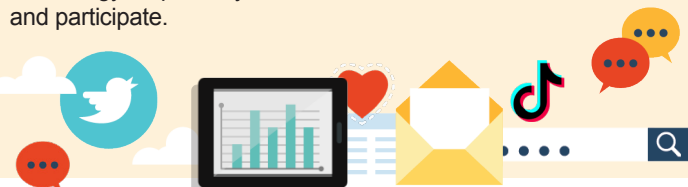
Clubs provide opportunities for students to engage in learning of their choice beyond the classroom.
