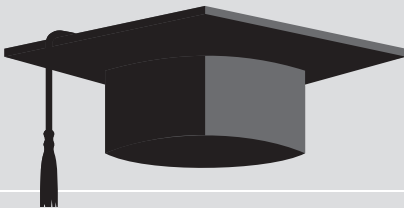

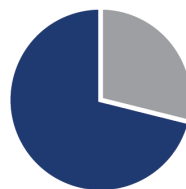

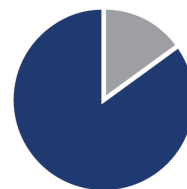

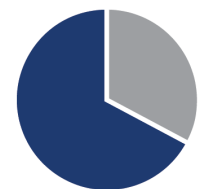
SAT Reading/Writing

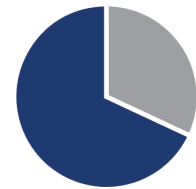

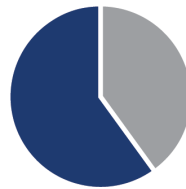

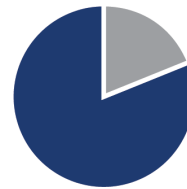

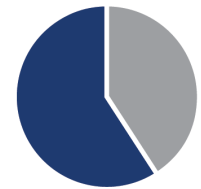
