### At Indian Creek Elementary, we believe:

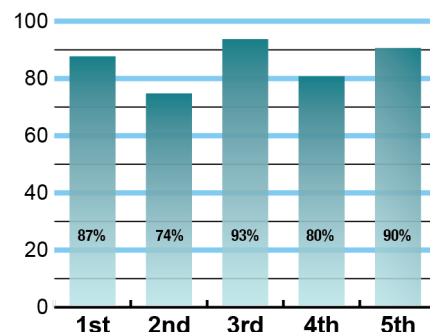
- Building strong relationships is vital in learning
