At Lewisville Elementary, we believe:

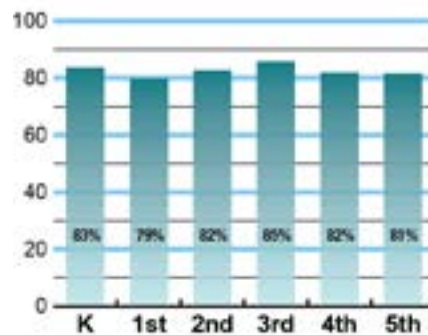
