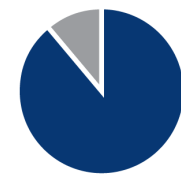

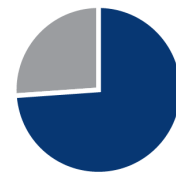

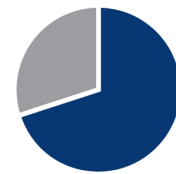

CLUBS

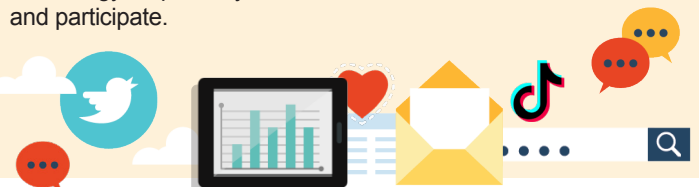
Clubs provide opportunities for students to engage in learning of their choice beyond the classroom.
