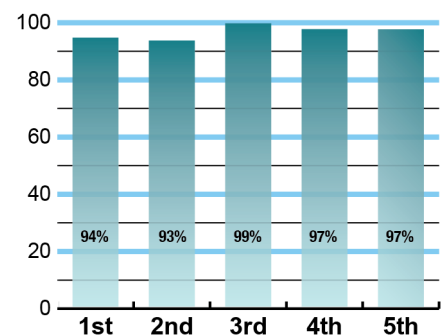
Our successes are a result of boundless positive energy, genuine dedication, and an amazing commitment toward teaching and learning from the Old Settlers students, staff, parents and community.
