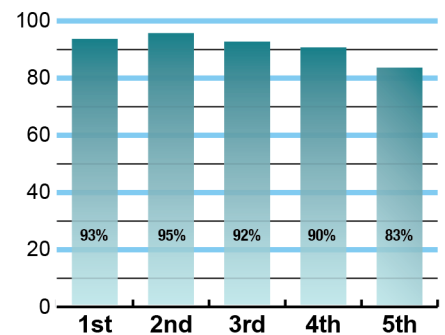

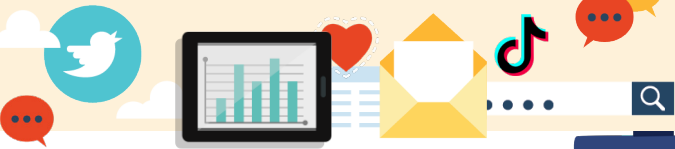


CLUBS
