Students will go through a metal detector and be wanded as they enter the security checkpoint before being allowed to enter the loading zone area. Carry cap [mortar board] and gown as you enter the security checkpoint. Make sure to secure your tassel. A program will be available to graduates on their chairs.

Students may only bring 1 car key. No wallets, cell phones, cameras or smart watches will be allowed. Exceptions will be made for medical requirements and/or special needs. Please contact your AP in advance for special accommodations. Students found with any unapproved items will be returned to their cars. It is recommended that students without pockets use a safety pin to pin their key inside their gown to prevent it from being lost.

Graduates will be seated on the field in chairs. When they receive their diploma Flash Photography will take two photos and email them to you. Please make sure your email is current on your senior's Skyward account. If you don't receive your proofs within a month, contact flash@airmail.net.

After the ceremony the graduates will have a recessional march out of the facility where they will meet their families in the Tostitos Championship Plaza, but that area will be so overcrowded so set up a place around The Star that you can meet your family and plan ahead of time since you will not have your cell phones. All students and family members should clear the Tostitos Championship Plaza by 5 pm.

DRESS CODE:

- **MALES:** Male students must wear black dress pants, a collared white dress shirt (no polo type) and black bow or necktie, and black dress shoes. **DO NOT WEAR ATHLETIC SHOES.**
- **FEMALES:** **Due to turf, no spiked heels/pumps will be allowed.** Female students must wear either a dress shorter than the gown or dress slacks with dress shoes or sandals that are black, nude, or white. Wear top or blouse that doesn't show at the neck of the gown. **Due to turf, no spiked heels/pumps will be allowed.** Wedges and sandals are ok if they don't have a high spike heel. It is suggested to wear flat comfortable shoes on the turf to prevent falls.
- **No t-shirts, jeans, shorts, spiked shoes, or pumps will be permitted.** No decorations on graduation cap or gown.
- **Only approved LHS Honor Stoles or cords will be allowed.** You can receive these from an LHS organization that you have earned 30 or more hours assisting.

In an effort to enhance public safety, Ford Center has modified its security policy by limiting the size and style of bags allowed in the venue.

APPROVED BAGS

CLEAR TOTE
Plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12"x6"x12"




PLASTIC STORAGE BAG
Clear, one (1) gallon, re-sealable



OR

SMALLER CLUTCH SIZE
Approximately the size of a hand with or without a handle or strap. No larger than 4.5" x 6.5" with or without a handle or strap. Can be carried separately or within an approved plastic bag.



PROHIBITED BAGS

PROHIBITED ITEMS INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- All purses, bags or containers larger than a small clutch bag
- Backpacks
- Binocular case
Binoculars may be worn around the neck
- Briefcases
- Camera bags
- Cinch bags
- Computer bags
- Coolers
- Diaper bags
- Fanny packs
- Luggage of any kind
- Seat Cushions



An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection at a gate designated for this purpose. Please limit the number of items you bring to the stadium on event days.

No one other than graduates & LISD staff is allowed on the field or in the loading zone area before, during or after the graduation exercise. **NO SIGNS, AIR HORNS, CONFETTI, BALLOONS OR LASER POINTERS WILL BE PERMITTED.** The Ford Center reserves the right to remove anyone not adhering to these policies.

BANNERS, SIGNS AND BALLOONS

NO BALLOONS will be allowed and all signs must be handheld (by one individual), event-related, in good taste and cannot obstruct another guest's view. They may not contain commercial messages, logos or political endorsements and may not be hung off affixed Ford Center structures. For select events (including all Frisco ISD high school games), banners will be permitted to be hung on railings, but cannot be affixed with adhesive tape, or obstruct video board or air intakes (the lowest portion of the field walls). Signs on poles or sticks, or constructed of wood or metal material, are also not permitted. Management reserves the right to confiscate signs, sticks and poles that are in violation of Ford Center policy.

PARENT/GUEST PARKING

*Guests are encouraged to Carpool to Graduation. Parking areas are generally open 90 minutes prior to high school events. The Ford Center is not responsible for and assumes no liability arising from accidents, fire, theft, damage or loss of the vehicle or article wherein while on Ford Center property. **Parking for guests is available in the Blue and Silver Garages, Gridiron Lot and Gaylord Lot.***

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

The handicap accessible drop-off entrance for students and guests is located off Gaylord Parkway north of the Omni Hotel Parking Garage entrance/exit. Please use elevator G.

Accessible parking spaces are available in each lot and are available on a first come/first served basis. A state-issued placard or license plate is required to park in accessible parking spaces. The person who has been issued the plate or placard must also be in the vehicle. Violators will be subject to citation and possible revocation of parking privileges.

DIRECTED PARKING SPACES

Once a guest enters a parking garage or lot, they may be directed to a parking spot by an attendant. Parking spots are for vehicles only. Drive aisles must remain clear at all times. No items (coolers, tents, tables, chairs, etc.) of any kind may be placed on the ground behind, in front of or around parked vehicles.

Guests who choose to watch from outside on the live-stream screens located in Tostitos Championship Plaza will not need a ticket.
