Calendar

- As you will see on website each group has 2 weeks on and 4 weeks off.
- We need your help as some students are "forgetting" when they have duty even though it is on the website and posted outside gym door.
- Perhaps if you print and post the calendar or have your child add it to their planner or electronic calendar to assist that would be wonderful.

Conflicts (academic, extra-curricular, illness, behavior)

1. Academics must come first.
2. We understand illness just give us a heads up.
3. If you are seeing behaviors at home that are not consistent with the code of ethics at home you may choose for your child to be off safety patrol. We will support you 100%.
4. Please encourage your child to let me or Ms. Nash know when there are conflicts. We just need to know ahead of time. The safety patrol calendar of duty is updated to January. If there is a conflict please let us know ahead of time not the day they are assigned.

However; to keep the continuity, your child must make up the days missed during off duty weeks.

Weather

We will still have duty on inclement weather days (below 40 and raining) please make sure your child is ready to be outside during colder days. We will have inside duty when it is too cold or wet outside. This is a great opportunity to teach ownership, consistency and responsibility. If a student is missing days and is not making them up, we will have no choice but to take them off of safety patrol.
