## Find Your Fact Family

- Before you begin the game, explain that there must be four members in your family (unless it's a double fact), and that each member has to share the same three numbers.
- It's best to copy the cards on cardstock and laminate them. Then cut them out and keep in sets.
- Count out the sets of cards that you'll need. For instance: If you have 20 students, you'll need 5 sets of fact families.
- Have some kind of music ready to play before you begin the game.
- Each student is given a card with a fact on it. (no one else sees it).
- Play music, and when the music stops, say "find your family."
- Once students have found all the members of their family, they sit down.
- Have a couple of the "families" explain how they found their "family".
