

TCHS – Cheerleader Behavior Contract

The Colony High School Cheer Handbook includes the following expectation for all cheerleaders:

Cheerleaders are expected to demonstrate exemplary character at all times. At practice, performances, and all cheer related events, cheerleaders are expected to have a positive attitude, work hard, be willing to learn new things and improve skills, encourage and help teammates, and show respect for each other, coaches, and other staff.

Cheerleaders who do not meet these expectations will be counseled by the coach about needed improvement and parents will be notified. If the cheerleader continues to fail to meet these expectations, he/she will be required to meet with a campus administrator and sign a behavior contract. Parents will be notified. Any failure to meet expectations after this point may result in removal from the squad.
