

TCHS Cheerleading Grading Policy



Daily Grades:

Will be given based on class participation and the class dress out. These grades will be worth 40% of the cheer grade and will be based on the amount of warnings given during a grading period and the number of times dressed incorrectly. These grades, unlike benchings will not accumulate; it will start again with a 100 at the next grading period. The grade will go down 5 points for each incorrect dress out, or not participating in class.

See example below:

Violations for grade deductions include: correct dress out/uniforms, hair/bangs not all up in a high pony tail/unnatural hair color, jewelry, nail polish, gum, bra straps showing at performances, having required items (poms, megaphone, binder etc.), on time to class/games/practices/performances, leaving the gym/field without permission and anything else determined by the coach.

0 violations =100

1 violation= 95

2 violations = 90

3 violations = 85

4 violations= 80

and so on.

Example: if a squad member does not dress out correctly one day, also has hair not properly put up and nails too long to participate in all activities, then they would already have an 85 (5 pts. Off for each thing) for that grading period since 3 items were not correct.

Test Grades (Major grades):

Will be worth 60% of the cheer grade and will be given at the discretion of the coach based on quality of performance.

Test grades include: Cheer/chant tests, paperwork due, games/performances, tumbling class, committee meetings and anything else determined by the coach.

*One half game suspension per season (one from March to August, football season and basketball season) for 3 minor violations must be worked off if received, but must be done with the coach within one week from the violation. Any squad member that does not complete the work off in the designated time will serve their half game and will still be responsible for finishing the remainder of the work off in the time designated by the coach.
