Theme: “A Beloved Community: Justice For All”

Eligible Participants: All Southern Denton County Students in Grades 4 - 12



Requirements: All work must be original and the title of your work must be the theme above which should be on the art piece. Your work should artistically present the impact of above on the people in society. It should represent Dr. King’s ideals, philosophy, and principles. Art canvas, poster board, or any quality art paper may be used. If using poster board or art paper, it must be matted. Measurements, including the matting, should be a minimum of 9” x12” and maximum of 16” x 20”. Art canvas does not need to be matted. GRAPHICS and GRAPHIC ART may be used for ENHANCEMENT but must comply with copyright laws. If the artwork is 3-D, it must be able to stand on its own or hang on a wall.

Name (w/phonetic pronunciation), phone, email, grade, school, and teacher’s name should be written on the back. Please tape a 3”X5” card with an explanation of your work on the back. One entry may be selected as the **\$250 Chairman’s Prize**.
