The Advanced Placement World History exam will be given on Thursday, May 11th. To prepare for this challenging test, Mr. Millhouse, Ms. Bouas, and Ms. Gray are offering study sessions to all former and present AP World History students. While these sessions are optional, it is expected that ANY student who signs up for the exam attend as many as possible. Not attending the sessions will most likely result in a lower test score!

Sessions will be interactive with the opportunity to ask questions and review valuable material. Bring your iPad and other academic resources to each session. There will be two sessions for each topic listed below. The sessions will be offered in the morning and after school. After school classes (PM) will be from 3:45 - 4:45 and morning classes (AM) will be from 7:05 - 8:05.
