

SENIOR EXEMPTIONS FROM FINAL EXAMS FALL, 2017

Exemptions from FALL final exams for seniors are calculated for each class individually beginning August 28th, 2017 for the 1st nine week & 18 week courses, and October 30th, 2017 for 2nd nine week courses. Attendance, for exemption purposes, is calculated during the course term (9 or 18 weeks). Grade averages, for exemption purposes, are based on the final nine week average.

ELIGIBILITY

Seniors are eligible for exemptions if the student meets the following criteria:

Exempt seniors will be required to attend class on the day of the exam for the 1 st and 3 rd grading periods. Students will not be required to attend class during the 2 nd and 4 th grading periods.		Exempt seniors are not required to be present for exams.	

Excused Absences

Below are the absences and their codes that count/do not count against exemptions:

Excused absences that **DO** count against exemptions:

- Doctor's excuses (E3)
- Absences due to illness, funerals, out of town trips (E1, E6, E7, E8)

Excused absences that **DO NOT** count against exemptions:

- Field trips (SS, SS1, SS2)
- Court-documented absences (CC)
- Approved religious holidays (RR)
- Two college visits (QQ)
- Medical Visits (MM)

Any codes, other than those listed above, will not be used to calculate exemptions and can be dismissed.

INELIGIBILITY

Unexcused Absences

If a student has an *unexcused absence*, the student is not exempt and will be required to take the final exam. *Unexcused absences* will begin with one of the following codes: **A, U, W**

Students are ineligible for exemptions in ALL CLASSES if the student has been:

- In Out of School Suspension (**EO**)
- In DAEP (LL or DU)
- Expelled

Has accumulated (3) tardies (JJ)
(3 tardies = one (1) unexcused absence.)
