

## EXEMPTIONS FROM FINAL EXAMS SPRING, 2018

Exemptions from SPRING final exams are calculated for each class individually beginning January 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2018 for 3<sup>rd</sup> nine weeks & 18 week courses and April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2018 for 4<sup>th</sup> nine week courses. Attendance, for exemption purposes, is calculated during the course term (9 or 18 weeks). Grade averages, for exemption purposes, are based on the final 9-week average.

# ELIGIBILITY

### ~SENIORS~

Seniors are eligible for exemptions if the student meets the following criteria.

Exempt seniors will be required to attend class on the day of the exam for the 1 <sup>st</sup> & 3 <sup>rd</sup> grading periods. Students will not be required to attend class during the 2 <sup>nd</sup> & 4 <sup>th</sup> grading periods.		Exempt seniors are not required to be present for exams.	

#### **EXCUSED ABSENCES**

Below are the absences and their codes (in bold) that do and do not count against exemptions:

<ul> <li>Excused Absences that DO Count Against Exemptions</li> <li>Doctor's excuses (E3)</li> <li>Absences due to illness, funerals, out of town trips (E1, E6, E7, E8)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Excused Absences that DO NOT Count Against Exemptions</li> <li>Field trips (SS, SS1, SS2)</li> <li>Court-documented absences (CC)</li> <li>District-approved religious holidays (RR)</li> <li>Two college visits (QQ)</li> <li>Medical Visits (MM)</li> </ul>		
Any codes, other than those listed above, will not be used to calculate exemptions and can be dismissed.			

#### ~AP STUDENTS ~

Students of *any grade level* enrolled in an AP class may be exempt from the final exam if they take the National AP EXAM for that subject and have at least an 85% class average. **\*\*IMPORTANT \*\*** *Any grade level of AP student may be exempt from their AP final exam, but they must be PRESENT and IN CLASS on that day.* Students who are exempt are not required to take the final exam, however, they may do so if they wish for a grade.

## INELIGIBILITY

#### **UNEXCUSED ABSENCES**

If a student has an *unexcused absence*, the student is not exempt and will be required to take the final exam. *Unexcused absences* will begin with one of the following codes: "A", "U", "W"

Students are ineligible for exemptions in ALL CLASSES if the student has been in:

- Out of School Suspension (EO)
- DAEP (LL or DU)
- Expelled

 Has accumulated (3) tardies (JJ) (3 tardies = (1) unexcused absence.)
