- You or your student can click the link, find their teacher, click on their teacher to see what is to be their learning for the week.
- This week, families will receive additional communication from teachers about learning plans and assignments.
- High school students will access their assignments through Canvas.
- Tuesday you will hear from us about the system teachers will use to communicate with students for at-home learning. Teachers are receiving training this week and will begin using the system to meet with students next week, starting April 6.
- Teachers will be able to record their virtual instruction, so students can access them at a later time.
- Students should spend about 2 hours per day on school work this week, as we are intentionally easing into at-home learning. We know our families are facing a lot of uncertainty, and we want to allow students and teachers time to adjust. We are in this together!
- We know students and families may be experiencing the need for support during this time, maybe support they have never needed in the past.
