Lewisville High School/LISD COVID-19 Guidelines for In-Person/On Campus Learning

Arrival Time: 7:30am-8:15am School Day Times: 8:20am-4:00pm Dismissal Time: 4:00pm-4:15pm Main Office Times: 7:40am-4:20pm

Students, we are excited for you to return to Lewisville High School in-person on Tuesday, September 8! It is our hope that if we all follow these basic guidelines, we can optimize the comfort, safety, and well-being of students, staff, and families

Preparing for the School Day:

- Wear school appropriate clothing and shoes (follow district dress code)
- Wear masks upon arrival and throughout the school day (Masks must be school appropriate a good rule to follow is that if it would be out of dress code on a t-shirt then it can't be displayed on a mask. Additionally, bandanas cannot be used as masks.
- Please remember, while we are level 'orange' there are no deliveries, including lunch deliveries

Arrivals:

- All car riders, walkers, and bikers must enter through the front doors
- All bus riders will enter through the back cafeteria doors where the bus drops students off
- All entry doors will be supervised by adult staff members
- All entry doors will be door stopped open for hands free entry
- All students will visit a sanitation station upon arrival
- Only students getting breakfast will be permitted to go the cafeteria
- No students will be allowed eat in the cafeteria past 7:45 at 7:45 students will take their food to class
- All OTHER students will proceed directly to their 1st period class

School Day:

- Students will follow their daily schedule, however, passing periods will be 10 minutes and we will stagger
 - release to minimize hallway crowding
- Students will be asked to wear their masks at all time except while they are eating
- Teachers and staff will wear face coverings throughout the school day
- Students and staff members must wear their face coverings when in close proximity
- Students will use QR codes to leave classrooms for any reason (no paper passes)
- All classrooms will have desk shields for additional safety
- Students and teachers will utilize hand sanitizer, soap and water
- All classrooms are set up to maximize social distancing as best as possible within the space
- Students will not have access to lockers

Lunch:

- All students will sit at cafeteria tables with no more than 3 to a table
- Individual meal service can be purchased in the cafeteria each school day
- All school lunches will be premade and pre-sacked there will be limited lunch choices
- Students will not be allowed to move from table to table

- Students should wear their masks when they are not eating
- Students will be encouraged to visit sanitation stations after lunch and throughout the day
- Reminder No lunch deliveries

<u>Dismissal</u>:

- Students will be dismissed on a staggered schedule
- Bus riders will exit from the cafeteria and will maintain social distancing while in line waiting to depart
- All walkers, bikers and car riders will dismiss out the door closest to their 4th period class
- Students will continue to wear their face coverings until they depart the campus
- Students will be supervised by staff members until they depart the campus

Buses

- Students may carry personal-sized hand sanitizer on buses and are encouraged to use their own hand sanitizer prior to boarding the school bus in the morning
- Campuses will have hand sanitizer available to students prior to boarding school buses in the afternoon
- Students will be required to wear facial coverings when on the bus
- When possible, windows on the bus will be opened to increase ventilation
- Distance between students will be maintained when possible and students will be seated strategically to maintain distance; however, TEA guidance does not require reducing bus capacity
- Buses will be cleaned after each route and will undergo thorough disinfection each day
- Families are encouraged to drop students off, carpool, or walk with their student to school when possible to reduce virus exposure on buses
