

# TCHS 2020: Prom Things to Remember

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- Prom tickets must be purchased prior to the event.
- Please retain your ticket receipt in case of discrepancies. We highly encourage you to bring your receipt or photo of the receipt to the event in case of discrepancies.
- Prom admission is non-transferable and **no refunds will be given**. Admission is good only for the person(s) listed on the receipt. The person purchasing the ticket(s) must present appropriate ID (school, driver's license, or military) when entering the prom, and their date must accompany them at the time of their arrival with their appropriate ID.
- Only guests that are under 21 years of age will be permitted to attend the prom.
- You must present photo identification to get into the event. Attendees must have a valid ID (school, driver's license, or military) at all times.
- All guests that are high school students from schools other than TCHS will be checked for discipline issues with their current school's administration.
- TCHS students are fully responsible for the actions of their guests who are from other townships or municipalities.
- Once an attendee leaves the facility and/or grounds, he/she will not be permitted to re-enter the event. In case of an emergency, a TCHS administrator can accompany an individual to and from his/her car which will thereby allow the students to re-enter the event.
- **Students will be held liable for any damages done to the Prom venue.**
- Food, drinks, and entertainment will be provided. The cost will be covered at the time of ticket purchases.
- Parents will not be permitted to enter the prom.
- Inappropriate dancing will not be allowed.
- Dress code for prom will be strictly enforced. If you are out of dress code, you will not be permitted to enter the prom venue.

## **Student safety is the primary concern of TCHS:**

Attendance at the prom is a privilege and not a right. Prom is a school sponsored event for which all school rules and policies apply and will be strictly enforced. All students and guests must conduct themselves in an orderly manner, remembering that their reputation and the reputation of our school depends on their behavior. All attendees must abide by all school rules while attending this school sponsored event. Anyone not conducting him/herself in an orderly and appropriate manner will be asked to leave the event and their parents will be notified immediately. Appropriate discipline procedures will follow in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct.

Any form of cigarette smoking, alcohol, and drug use is not permitted by the attendees or their guest on the venue property at any time. Anyone suspected to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be reported to campus administration and the police officers on duty. Fighting, insubordination, unsafe acts, or illegal activity will not be tolerated. Disciplinary actions and referral to the appropriate law officials will be highly enforced.
