

HEDRICK SITE OPTIONS

Build only a new middle school on the current property



ADVANTAGE MORE SPACE

- Provides more space on the site for a larger middle school building consistent with District standards
- Provides athletic fields and track consistent with needs of a middle school

DISADVANTAGE RELOCATION

- Elementary students and campus staff would be relocated to another elementary school.

ADVANTAGE RESOURCE STEWARDSHIP

- Better utilizes current elementary school capacity

DISADVANTAGE NEIGHBORHOOD

- Movement away from neighborhood elementary school

2017-2021 OPERATING COSTS



ADVANTAGE FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY

- Saves construction costs of new elementary school building.
- Saves ongoing operational costs for the elementary school.

DISADVANTAGE BUSSING COSTS

- Bussing costs would increase to transport elementary students to other campuses.

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- Regardless of which option is chosen, all students would be zoned for Hedrick Middle School and Lewisville High School.
- Our valued staff members would remain part of the LISD family.
- Construction would not begin before the completion of the 2017-18 school year, at the earliest.

HEDRICK SITE OPTIONS

Build both a new middle school and a new elementary school on the current property



ADVANTAGE NEIGHBORHOOD

- Students would have a neighborhood elementary and middle school.

DISADVANTAGE MOVING STUDENTS

- Elementary students likely would be moved twice - once at the beginning of construction and again upon completion of construction.

DISADVANTAGE OUTDOOR SPACE



ADVANTAGE TWO NEW FACILITIES

- Both elementary and middle school students would have brand new buildings.
