IMPORTANT NOTICE: STUDENT PASSWORD RESET Ends TODAY!

The LISD Technology Office is facilitating a password reset for ALL LHS Harmon students regardless if they have a district issued iPad.

This password links them to everything they would use – google classroom, Canvas, email, etc.

The passwords <u>must</u> be reset with LISD district technology staff here on the LHS Harmon campus. If students do this even before, they will have to re-do this process.

LHS Harmon will begin the password reset process during 1st and 2nd periods on Wednesday, March 27th and will run through Friday, March 29th.

Students meanwhile may be thinking of a new password by following the guidelines below:

Student Password Change Information

- The password change is not optional
- You CAN NOT use a password you have used before
- Know the password you will use before coming to the Password Change Area by using the below information to create a secure password
- Your new password must be at least 8 characters long
 - Characters: Letters and Numbers
- Your new password must have each of the character's listed below.
 - o One (or more) Uppercase Letter
 - One (or more) Lowercase Letter
 - One (or more) Number (0-9)
 - O Optional: You can also use any special character from this list:

- Put your new password to a test! If you can answer **YES** to all of these questions then you are one step away from having a secure password that you can use.
 - o Is my new password at least 8 characters long?
 - O Does my new password have one (or more) uppercase letter?
- A, B, C,...Z
 - O Does my new password have one (or more) lowercase letter?
- a, b, c,...z
 - O Does my new password have one (or more) number?
- **■** 0123456789
- Final Password Test! If you can answer **NO** to all of these questions then you have created a secure password that you can use. Great Job!!

- O Have I ever used my new password before at Lewisville ISD?
- O Does my new password include any part of my name?
- Post Malone (or) Post (or) Malone
 - O Does new my password contain repeating letters?
- \blacksquare ZZZZ
 - o Does new my password contain consecutive numbers?

Spanish Credit by Exam Sign Up - April 8th deadline

Exam Date: April 16th & 17th

Students will be offered the opportunity to sign up for the Spanish CBE during Farmer Flex time. The format of the test has changed to where a student will be able to show fluency through sections in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Based on individual fluency, the end results will show the number of credits earned in Spanish instead of just taking a specific test like in years past. **We will administer the Spanish Spring CBE April 16**th **and 17**th.

Here are some guidelines for the students to know:

- a. They must be able to read, speak, and write Spanish.
- b. This test is for students *not currently enrolled* in a Spanish class----this test should only be for students who wish to gain credits by exam instead of taking Spanish courses.
- c. Counselors will check to see if credits have been earned previously; Students can also check by downloading their transcript in Skyward under Portfolio/2019 Transcript.
- d. The deadline for sign-up will be April 8th. Unlike previous years, we have to submit how many students will be testing a few weeks beforehand to order/prepare for the test.
