We have a Farmer Tip Line for students to anonymously report issues directly to campus administration. There are posters around the building and in classrooms with

our Farmer Tip Line number. Use this tip line to anonymously report issues\_such as bullying, suicidal thoughts or self-harm, dating or family violence, weapons, drugs, threats, or other alarming behavior.

Student safety is our number one priority, so remember: *See Something. Say Something.* 

#### Safety Reminders:

In response to the tragedy in Florida, LISD is vamping up on security measures, both campus wide and district wide.

Know that there will be very little tolerance for not following these safety measures:

- Every student **MUST** have an ID visible at all times.
- <u>Immediately</u> report anyone you see in the building who does not have an ID on or look like he/she belongs.
- **Never** prop open or let anyone into the building from a side door. All visitors must enter through the front and go into the office.
- If you see <u>ANYTHING</u> that you know is out of the ordinary, question it. Ask your teacher, send an email to Officer Alexander or Mr. Fontana, etc. It is <u>everyone's</u> <u>responsibility</u> to keep our campus safe!
