April 29-May 3.

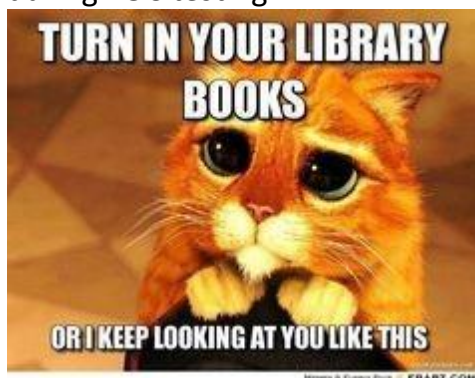
