- ★ LISD and Collin College are committed to increasing dual credit opportunities for our students and building the Collegiate Academy program at TCHS.



### What is the LISD Collegiate Academy?

- ★ Unique Academic Experience
  - ★ Lewisville ISD students can earn required high school credits while potentially earning an Associate's Degree
  - ★ College curriculum with high school structure-'school within a school'
  - ★ Creates pathway from high school to college
  - ★ Head start on college will minimize tuition costs

9th grade	2 courses	6 hours	
10th grade	1-3 courses	3-9 hours	
11th grade	4-8 courses	12-24 hours	
12th grade	6-9 courses	18-27 hours	

- ★ Students graduate on the FHSP with endorsement at the Distinguished Level of Achievement
- ★ Students have opportunity to earn multiple endorsements
- ★ Students receive performance acknowledgements for dual credit course completion

If accepted, students will work with staff to complete a four-year plan.

#### **Dual Credit Benefits & Information**

- ★ Long term studies on students who took at least 20 dual credit hours were more likely to...
  - Graduate from high school,
  - Start college in a 4-year institution,
  - Enroll in college full time, and
  - Stay in college at least two years.
