What is CIS?

CIS is a nonprofit agency that coordinates and provides free school based services to help students overcome barriers, succeed in school, and prepare for life.

Services CIS can provide 80 case-managed students:

Behavior:

- Students who could use help in the following areas:
 - Self-esteem
 - Social skills
 - Anger management
 - Classroom behavior
 - Dealing with a family crisis
 - Goal setting

*Individual and group supportive guidance

Academics:

- Providing students with academic support in the form of grade monitoring.
- Students in need of academic support or encouragement. Academic goal setting.
- Pairing students with tutors as available.

Mentors:

CIS will pair students with mentors, as they are available. Students will see their mentors individually on weekly basis who are there to provide additional supportive guidance.
