



LUNCH

Lunches are 11:25-12:25 daily.

Students are assigned an A Lunch (11:25-11:55) or B Lunch (11:55-12:25) on Advisory Days based on their 2nd period class location.

Students can purchase lunch, bring a lunch from home, or have lunch delivered by a parent.

Deliveries can only be made by a student's parent/guardian and cannot be brought for any other students.

Food should have the student's name clearly marked on the outside and dropped off between 11:25-12:05.

We cannot be responsible for food that goes missing.

Deliveries from restaurants or delivery services cannot be made under any circumstances.

TARDIES

Students receive two "free" tardies per 18-week semester.

Tardies 3-7: Lunch detention

Tardies 8+: One day of PASS (ISS) / tardy

SIGNING IN/OUT

All students must be signed out by a parent/guardians through the front office when leaving during the school day.


