In Skyward under **Educational Milestones** you will find a link to the TEA Data Portal and your student's unique access code. If you do not see it, you can retrieve the access code by clicking "Where is my unique access code?". You will fill in your student's name, date of birth, and PEIMS number. You can then view your student's Texas testing history.
