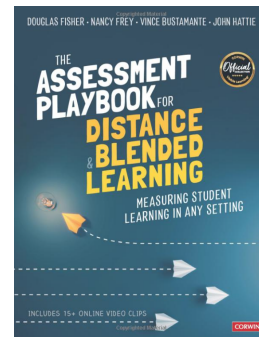
Blended Learning (3 hours) | Topic: Formative Assessment
