Get your questions answered and talk with other parents who have "been there"! Afterwards, you will receive a summary of topics discussed, with helpful tips for using the skills at home.

Family Counseling (6:30 to 7:00 pm): Family counseling offers all members of the family an opportunity to share their honest perspectives and discuss solutions in a caring manner. Each family may meet for up to six sessions with a solution-focused, non-judgmental approach. How might your family be different if the problem were gone or your situation were improved?
