

supplies, books, printers, student awards, and guest speakers.











Traffic Flow for Dismissal

- SLOW DOWN and watch crossing guards/cross traffic
- Arrows guide traffic
- If you want to turn left onto Old Settlers, pick up in front. No pick up allowed on Old Settlers
- If you want to turn right onto Old Settlers, pick up in back
- Students must use cross walk in back lot to go to ride. Don't walk in between cars in line.
- 2 outside lanes for pick up must pull forward
- Middle lane is for moving cars
- Expect delays on Day 1

STUDENT SAFETY

A critical ingredient in the safe school recipe is the classroom response to an incident at school. Weather events, fire, accidents, intruders and other threats to student safety are scenarios that are planned and trained for by students, teachers, staff and administration.

Our school is expanding the safety program to include the Standard Response Protocol -Extended (SRPx). The SRPx is based on these five actions. Lockout, Lockdown, Evacuate, Shelter and Hold. In the event of an emergency, the action and appropriate direction will be called on the PA.

LOCKOUT - "Get Inside, Lock Outside Doors" LOCKDOWN - "Locks, Lights, Out of Sight" EVACUATE - "To the Announced Location" SHELTER - "For a Hazard Using a Safety

TRAINING

LOCKOUT

GET INSIDE, LOCK OUTSIDE DOORS

Lockout is called when there is a threat or hazard outside of the school building.

STUDENTS:

- Return to inside of building.
- Do business as usual

LOCKDOWN LOCKS, LIGHTS, OUT OF SIGHT

Lockdown is called when there is a threat or hazard inside the school building.

STUDENTS: Move away from sight.

- Maintain silence

TEACHERS:

- Lock classroom door Lights out
- Move away from sight.
- Maintain silence
- Wait for First Responders to open door
- · Take roll, account for students

EVACUATE TO A LOCATION

Evacuate is called to move students and staff from one location to another

STUDENTS:

- · Bring your phone
- Leave your stuff behind
- Form a single file line
- Show your hands
- Be prepared for alternatives during response

TEACHERS:

- Grab roll sheet if possible
- Lead students to Evacuation Location
- Take roll, account for students

FOR A HAZARD USING SAFETY STRATEGY

Shelter is called when the need for personal protection is

SAMPLE HAZARDS:

- Tornado
- Hazmat

SAMPLE SAFETY STRATEGIES:

- Evacuate to shelter area.
- Seal the room.

STUDENTS:

- Appropriate hazards and safety strategies TEACHERS:
- Appropriate hazards and safety strategies
- Take roll, account for students

HOLD IN YOUR CLASSROOM


Hold is called when the hallways need to be kept clear. even during class changes.

STUDENTS:

- Remain in your classroom
- Do business as usual.

TEACHERS:

- Recover students and staff from hallways.
- Close and lock classroom door
- Take roll, account for students

Bus Routes

- No registration is necessary; your child's bus driver will have paperwork for you

Student ID Badges

Beginning this year, all LISD middle school students are required to wear ID badges on a lanyard at all times while in the building.

Students who fail to follow this requirement will receive a temporary ID, and will be subject to consequences according to the frequency of the offense.

Students will receive complimentary badges and lanyards the first week of school, and we will review all expectations.

A lost ID can be replaced at the front office for \$5. A lost lanyard can be replaced for \$1.

New Student Passwords

- Today, August 1st, all students & parents received an email from LISD Technology alerting you to change your LISD Student Password. It will be RESET. You MUST change your password before August 15th.
- You can change your password through Skyward Family Access or https://password.lisd.net/
- On 8/16 the district password will go into effect.

Attendance

- See the McKamy Student Handbook on the McKamy website: www.mckamy.lisd.net
 - To receive credit in a class, a student must attend at least 90% of the school year.
 - Students must bring a note from a parent if the parent did not call or email the attendance clerk. If parent called or emailed concerning their student's absence no note is required.
 - If a student was at the doctor, then they SHOULD bring a medical note. This helps in regards to funding and decisions made by the attendance committee regarding excessive absences.
 - Per LISD Board Policy, work missed DURING AN UNEXCUSED ABSENCE cannot be made up and the grade will be zero.
 - Students are allowed no more than eight (8) parent notes per year for absences.



Planned Absences



- Communication is key
- The principal is designated to make decisions about absences being excused (other than illness, family emergencies, deaths in the family)
- Prior notification is required
- Pre-Approved Absence Forms, located in the front office and on our website, are <u>required</u>
 - LISD Principals may not approve more than 8 parent notes for absences this school year, and no more than 6 can be in one semester.

- Annual Insurance Benefit Program Coverage:
- \$40 Annual Insurance Benefit Program Fee: All students who opt in to the 1:X program pay this fee

What does it Cover:

- 1st break or loss at NO CHARGE
- 2nd break \$50 copay (Ipad only)
- 3rd and subsequent breaks, repair or full replacement cost.

Accessory Replacement Cost:

- \$40 copay for 1st break or loss of smart keyboard
- \$100 Copay 2nd break or loss of smart keyboard
- \$110 full replacement cost for 3rd break or loss of smart keyboard.


