VSP- Sight for Students Program

SightforStudents.org

This is a program available throughout the district that provides comprehensive eye exams as well as eye glasses for students 18 years and under. A voucher is given to the student or parent who then can go on the website to find a participating provider closest to them.

To access information on where to get vouchers go to <u>www.sightforstudents.org</u> and under the Parents/Guardians tab choose Find a Partner then enter zip code. This will populate a list of partners who are authorized to give the vouchers needed for exams and eyeglasses. To find a provider go to the same website and under the Parents/ Guardians tab click on Find a Provider then enter zip code. This will populate a list of eye doctors in your area that accept these vouchers.

The qualifying guidelines are as followed:

- Must fall under the 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines *See Guideline Chart Below
- Not have Medicaid or any private insurance
- Must be 18 years of age or younger
- Have valid social security number
- Not participated in the VSP eye program within the last 12 months
