What is VLA?

The Virtual Learning Academy provides supplementary online high school courses for students across the Lewisville Independent School District. These courses are available to all students in LISD. All of the VLA courses are available for original credit. VLA has 3 Terms: Fall, Spring, and Summer. LISD VLA courses taken during the school day are at no cost to the student. LISD VLA classes taken outside the school day and all TXVSN classes have a course fee assessed. Fees range from No Fee to \$400 per half credit class.

Why take an online VLA class?

Students were asked why they selected to take classes through VLA. The top 5 responses were:

1. I wanted to be able to work on my own time
2. I wanted to open my schedule for additional AP Classes
3. I wanted to open my schedule for more Fine Arts
4. I wanted to experience a different type of learning environment
5. I wanted to graduate early

What are some of the other benefits to taking a course through VLA?

Students taking online courses through VLA have a chance to develop important self-regulatory skills that have been closely linked to success in college and career. Among these are planning, monitoring work and progress, developing mechanisms for controlling their learning/work environments and the ability to reflect on their learning and work progress.

We have a full catalog of courses available for original credit. All courses count in GPA, Class Rank and UIL. All classes are NCAA approved.
