## **Parent Responsibilities**

**We, as parents, will support our children's learning in the following ways:**

- Volunteer and/or observe in my child's classroom if possible.
- If the school district moves to remote instruction or my child is enrolled in virtually learning, I will participate as the learning coach.
- Participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my child's education.
- Promote positive use of my children's extracurricular time.
- Stay informed about my child's education and communicate with school by promptly reading all notices from the school and responding, as appropriate.

## **Student Responsibilities**

**We, as students, will share the responsibility to learn at school and at home by:**

- Do my homework every day and ask for help when I need to.
- Read at least 15 to 30 minutes everyday outside of school time.
- Give all notices and information received from my school to my parents or guardian every day.
- Pay attention and follow The Great 8 Expectations both at home and at school.

## **School Responsibilities**

**Parkway Elementary School will:**

- Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards.
- Hold parent-teacher conferences (at least annually) to discuss the individual child's achievement.
- Provide parents with frequent reports on their child's progress.
- Provide parents reasonable access to staff.
- Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities.
