UNIFORM DRESS CODE POLICY

SCHOOL COLORS: MAROON AND WHITE

1. UNIFORM MUST BE WORN EVERY DAY.
2. CLOTHING WILL BE PROPER SIZE, FIT, AND LENGTH
3. ONLY PLAIN WHITE OR BLACK SHIRTS CAN BE WORN UNDER SCHOOL SHIRT. UNDERGARMENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO SHOW.
4. PANTS, SHORTS, AND SKIRTS ARE TO BE WORN AT THE NATURAL WAISTLINE. PANTS MUST NOT BE BAGGY, CUTOFF, WITH HOLES, SPLIT, FRAYED, OR ROLLED AT THE BOTTOM.
5. SHORTS AND/OR SKIRTS ARE TO BE NO SHORTER THAN MID - THIGH.
6. SWEATERS OR HOODIES SHOULD BE WORN OVER A UNIFORM TOP.
7. JACKETS WILL REMAIN OFF WHILE IN THE BUILDING, AND PER TEACHER DISCRETION WITHIN THE CLASSROOM.
8. SHOES AND SOCKS WILL BE WORN EVERY DAY. SANDALS WITH A CLOSED TOE AND ANKLE STRAP PERMITTED. NO FLIP FLOPS.
9. ANY CLOTHING WITH HAND WRITING, IS NOT PERMITTED.

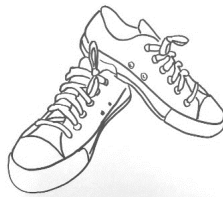
