By following these guidelines you can set a proper example for our students and make the concert more enjoyable for all. Thank you for your assistance.

- ❖ Avoid entering or leaving the room during a performance. If absolutely necessary to do so, move only between numbers.
- ❖ Applause is welcomed, but whistling or cheering is considered inappropriate for a formal concert.
- ❖ Talking should be avoided during a performance.
- ❖ Attention should be directed to the performer at all times.

Please, silence or turn-off cell phones.

Please, no flash photography during the performance, it's distracting to the performers and the audience.

If you are videotaping the performance, please set your camera up on the side or in the back. Please don't block the line of sight for those sitting behind you. Thank you for your cooperation.
