### Hold Harmless 2020-21

- Second half of school year
- In-person attendance is the determining factor.
- Federal Stimulus Money
  - 1st Round Last year \$ into formulas
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Round \$17 Million
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Round \$37.5 Million (ESSER 3)
    - 20% must go towards learning loss
    - Can look back and look forward

### Looking Ahead to Fiscal 2021-22

- Property values
  - 9% Growth projected
  - \$1 Billion new property on rolls
- Enrollment trends
  - Flat enrollment
  - Modest virtual component for SY 2021–22
- Staff attrition COVID (PK-2), 2/3 back next fall
- Recapture
- ▶ HB 3

> 2021-22	M + O to go down	\$0.3809	

### Legislature is in Session

- Texas Economy
  - Driven by oil and gas price of crude
  - State Deficit much lower near zero, now surplus
  - Ability to maintain HB 3 gains to public education so far, so good
- Impact of HB 3 to LISD recapture State House and State Senate agreed in principle to extend.
- HB 3 impact on LISD recapture was as follows:
  - Fiscal Year 2019 \$30 Million (Audited)
  - Fiscal Year 2020 \$16 Million (Audited)
  - Fiscal Year 2021 \$32 Million (Budgeted)
  - Fiscal Year 2022 \$50+ Million (Projected)
